

The opening of the InterContinental Washington, D.C. - The Wharf is good news for the city's southern waterfront industrial district. The 278-room hotel features Potomac views, a rooftop pool, and Executive Chef Kwame Onwuachi's Afro-Caribbean restaurant. From \$350. wharfintercontinentaldc.com

Mondrian Park Avenue, New York has opened in the buzzy NoMad neighborhood near Madison Square Park and the Flatiron District. The 189-room hotel has a rooftop bar, hip underground club space, and the New York outpost of Cleo, Chef Danny Elmaleh's wildly successful, LA restaurant. From \$400. mondrianparkavenue.com

After a multimillion-dollar renovation, The Bloomsbury, London's West End hotel originally designed by architect Sir Edwin Lutyens, sparkles with a gloriously vintage but totally updated leather-and-Murano look. From \$260. doylecollection.com

The Douglas, part of Marriott's Autograph Collection, has opened downtown in Vancouver's newest entertainment district, Parq Vancouver. The hotel's 188 wood-paneled rooms and suites are a nod to the area's massive Douglas firs. Stroll through the sixth-floor park. From \$275. thedouglasvancouver.com

A former coconut plantation reimagined as a 58-acre resort of 175 suites and poolside villas overlooking the blue Pacific, the Ritz-Carlton, Koh Samui in Thailand features a one-of-a-kind Swim Reef for snorkeling with 50-plus varieties of exotic fish. From \$420. ritzcarlton.com

Mandarin Oriental's Pink Sands Club, Canouan is a resort of six colonial-style villas and 26 suites located on an idyllic stretch of white-sand beach protected by a large natural coral reef. From \$1,400. mandarinoriental.com

With 77 high-ceilinged (and acoustically perfect) guest rooms in the former Royal Danish Academy of Music downtown, Nobis Hotel Copenhagen employs a private chef to prepare Redzepi-like feasts (lobster with pickled rose hips) in your room. A neo-gothic showpiece, 1898 the Post in Ghent, Belgium, is a former post office turned into a 38-room boutique hotel with antique furniture, marble tubs, and 360-degree views from the Tower Suite. From \$465, including breakfast. zannierbotels.com

The East Coast (think Hamptons) blends with the laid-back vibe of coastal California at the 392-room Westdrift Manhattan Beach in Los Angeles. Find a sunny, breezy, legitimately cool vibe at this new Autograph Collection hotel. From \$219. westdrift.com

As a private estate, Chateau de Fonscolombe in Le Puy-Sainte-Réparade, France, hosted European royals. Newly opened as a five-star hotel, the stately Provence home has 50 bedrooms with views over gardens and vineyards. Try organic wines in the tasting room. The tony, new 119-room Bulgari Hotel
Beijing (below) is surrounded by sculpted
gardens in the heart of the exclusive Embassy
District. Suits and locals meet in Il Bar for
